

## RULEI VIÑA BARRACALLO Tempranillo – Garnacha 2011

A nice but exciting wine for its touch of maturity with a subtle sweetness.

The perfect blend of Tempranillo grapes from a 35-year-old vineyard (Viña Barracallo) and a little of Garnacha grapes from a vineyard over 100 years old (Viña El Moral) that generates a versatile wine suitable for all types of situations and tastings, alone or accompanied.

Ageing: 12 months in French and American oak barrels (70%-30%) of 225l.

Tasting: Ruby red colour with picota reflections, smells of black fruits, pepper, liquorice, cocoa and dark chocolates. Friendly, sweet and tasty with a good fusion of wood and with a prolonged end of black plum.
